Administrator interface

Accessing the reviews interface

First, login to your Episerver CMS interface via the URL provided to you by your system administrator. Once authenticated, you can open the review administration interface by following those steps:

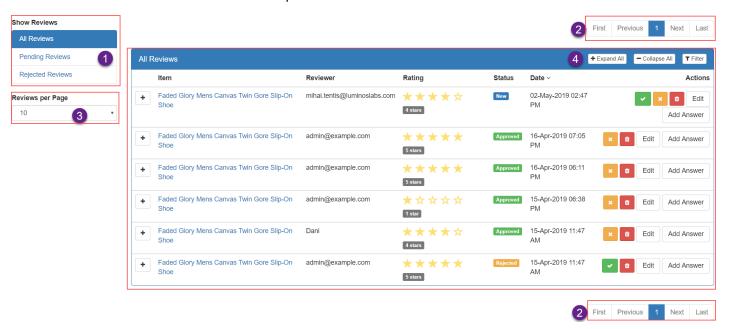


- 1. In the Episerver global menu, access the "Reviews" section
- 2. In the "Reviews" section, click on the "Reviews" button
 - a. By default, this should open automatically once the 1st step is completed

Using the reviews interface

The reviews interface consists of several elements. Each element is described in greater detail in subchapters below.

- 1. "Show reviews" section choose what type of reviews you see in the table
- 2. Pagination controls navigate between multiple pages of reviews
- 3. "Reviews per Page" controls choose how many reviews are displayed at a time
- 4. Reviews table See and interact with posted reviews



"Show reviews" section

This section allows you to filter the reviews displayed in the table by their status:

- 1. All Reviews will display all reviews (New, Pending & Rejected), regardless of their status
 - a. This is the default selection
- 2. Pending Reviews will display only reviews which have the status "New"
- 3. Rejected Reviews will display only reviews which have the status "Rejected"

Show Reviews



Pagination controls

Displayed above and below the reviews table, the pagination controls allow you to navigate between multiple pages.

By default, you will see to the first page of reviews. You can navigate between pages by clicking the Previous/Next & First/Last buttons.

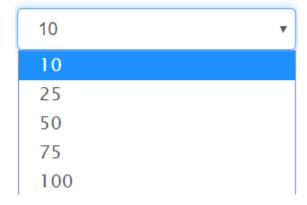


"Reviews per page" section

From here you will be able to select how many reviews you want to be displayed at a time in the reviews table. The default selection is 10, but you can choose to display more (25, 50, 75 or 100).

Selecting any option within the drop-down menu will also impact the pagination controls; Seeing more reviews at a time means a lower number of pages to scroll through, and vice-versa.

Reviews table

In the reviews table you can see reviews and interact with them.

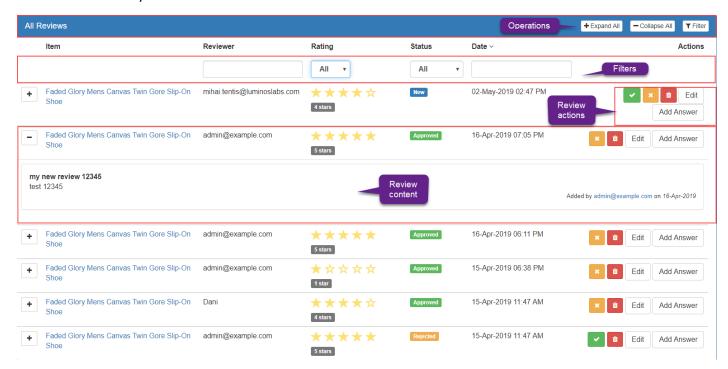


Table operations

At the top of the table, three operations can be performed:

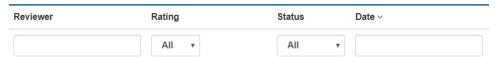
- 1. "Expand all" Will expand all the currently visible reviews, displaying their contents
- 2. "Collapse all" Will collapse all the currently visible reviews, hiding their contents
- 3. "Filter" Will display the filter bar (see "Table filters" below)



Table filters & sorting

The filter bar, once expanded, allows you to filter the displayed reviews by the following criteria

- 1. Reviewer this is a text field, for the reviewer's email address
- 2. Review rating dropdown menu with options ranging from 1 to 5 stars, including an "All" option
- 3. Status dropdown menu with the following options (All, New, Approved, Rejected)
- 4. Date



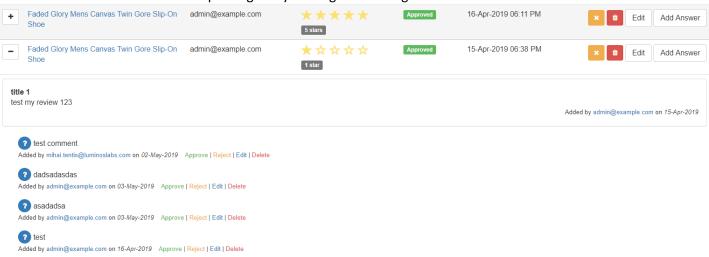
Clicking the table heading for either of the filters will sort the table in an ascending/descending manner based on that column. The filters do not have to be expanded for sorting to work.

Review content

Each review is displayed as a individual line in the table and can be interacted with For each review you will see the following information

- 1. Name of the item which has been reviewed clicking this will open the product's page in the Episerver administration interface
- 2. Name of the reviewer
- 3. Product rating in stars
- 4. Review status
- 5. Date of review posting
- 6. Review details title, content, answers & comments. Those are displayed only if the review is expanded

All reviews are by default collapsed but can be expanded to reveal the details by clicking the left-aligned "+" button. The review can be collapsed again by clicking the left-aligned "-" button

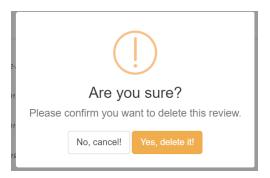


Review actions

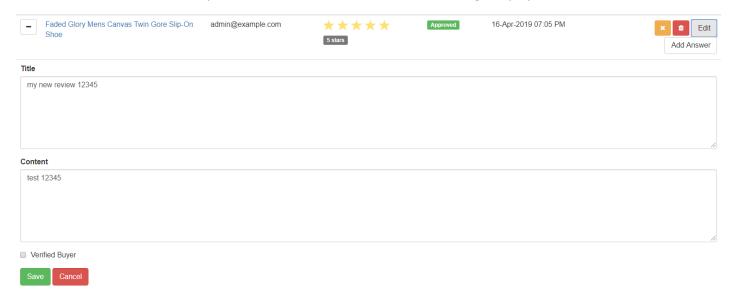
Based on the state a review is in, several actions can be performed on it. The actions are visible in the right-most part of each review:

- Approval only available for new/rejected reviews. Clicking this will approve the review and make it visible on the website
- Reject only available for new/approved reviews. Clicking this will reject the review, and if visible, hide it from the website

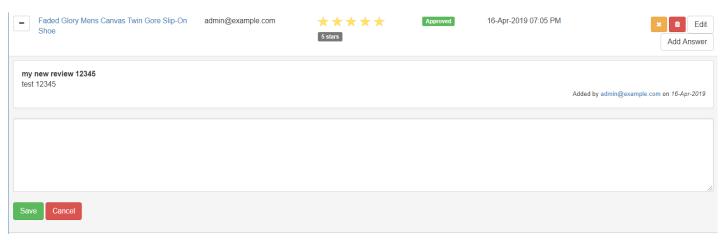
• Delete – available for all reviews. Clicking this inform you that if you continue, the review will be permanently deleted from the website.



• Edit – available for all reviews. Clicking this will allow you to edit a reviews title & content and mark it as a "verified buyer" review. A verified review will have a badge displayed on the PDP.



 Add answer – available for all reviews. Clicking this will allow you to add an answer to the posted review



See the table below for a more visual description of which action can be performed on which review

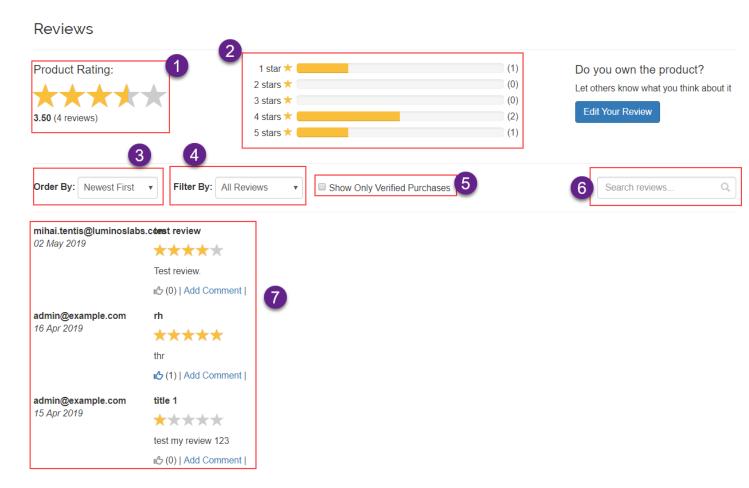
Website

In order to view a product's reviews, add or edit an existing review, a user must navigate to that product's product detail page.

Review section

The reviews section contains multiple elements with which the user can interact, each of them being described below:

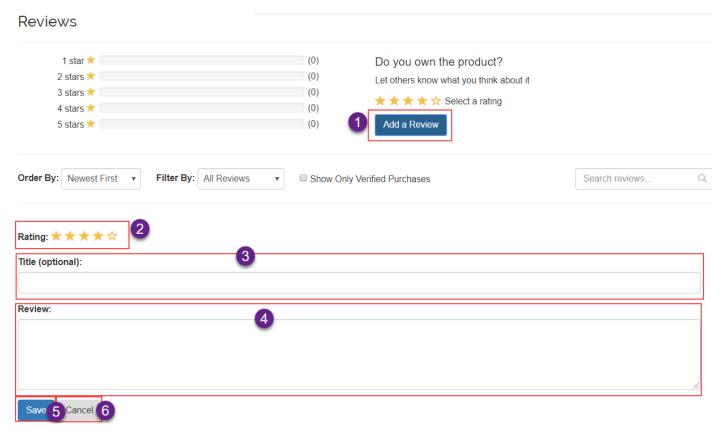
- 1. Total product rating. The aggregate rating of all the reviews, being displayed as both stars and as a number. The total number of reviews is also shown
- 2. A breakdown of the reviews displaying the number of reviews for each rating(1-5 stars)
- 3. Sorting allows the user to sort by two criteria
 - a. "Newest first" Orders all reviews by posting date (default option)
 - b. "Most popular" Orders all reviews by number of likes
- 4. Filtering allows the user to select only certain reviews to be displayed. The options are:
 - a. "All reviews" Displays all reviews (default option)
 - b. "1-star reviews" Displays only reviews with 1-star rating
 - c. "2-star reviews" Displays only reviews with 2-star rating
 - d. "3-star reviews" Displays only reviews with 3-star rating
 - e. "4-star reviews" Displays only reviews with 4-star rating
 - f. "5-star reviews" Displays only reviews with 5-star rating
- 5. The user can choose to see only reviews from users which have been marked by an administrator as a verified buyer
- 6. The user can search for a certain term within all reviews. Searching will display only reviews which contain that term in their title/content
- 7. The actual reviews contain the following:
 - a. The reviewer's information
 - b. Posting date
 - c. Review rating
 - d. Review title & content
 - e. Number of likes Clicking this button will award a like to the specific review
 - f. "Add comment" button Clicking this will open a text input, allowing the user to leave a comment to the review



Adding reviews

A user must be signed in in order to post a review. Otherwise, the "Add a review" button does nothing when clicked. Below you will find the flow for a signed in user

- 1. Clicking the "Add a review" button in a product's review section will expand the review form
- 2. The rating, in stars, must be chosen
- 3. An optional title can be filled out
- 4. The content of the review must be filled out
- 5. Saving the review will submit it for approval. It will not be posted on the website until an administrator moves it from the status "New" to "Approved"
- 6. Canceling will discard all the progress and close the review form



Editing a review

A user may only submit one review per product. Once a review has been submitted and approved, the "Add a review button" changes to "Edit your Review".

Clicking it will reveal the same review form as above, pre-filled with the existing information.

If no changes are made to the review, it will continue to be visible.

If the review is edited & submitted with new details, its status will go back to "New", and it will be hidden until approved again.
